Girls Championship – Round 2 Highlights

Fort Worth, TX. – The annual Fort Worth Junior Golf Association’s Girls Championship tournament continued today at three courses, Ridglea Country Club (Championship and 1st Flights), Squaw Creek Golf Course (2nd – 5th Flights) and Pecan Valley Golf Course (9-Hole Division). Today, the 18-hole girls were divided into flights while the 9-hole competitors continued to play in match play brackets.

In the Championship Flight, Trinity King extended her lead in the tournament to 13 under, posting a score of 69 on Ridglea’s north course. Malisone Chanthapanya took command of 2nd place at 2 over, posting a round 2 score of 73 for a tournament total of 145. Caitlyn Lindell fell into 3rd place at 12 over for the tournament.

In the 1st Flight, JJ Betz and Allyson Barth are tied for first with a total 2 day score of 163 over Kodie Winnings and Ellah Bradshaw who are tied for third with a 2 day score of 168.

In the 2nd Flight, Mallory Franke has the lead with a total of 166 with Falicity Reeves close behind at 168 and Kaila McAbee at 173 for third place.

In the 3rd Flight, Kristen Wallace leads (180) with Gigi Carmona (181) holding on to second. Lauren Wallace and Georgia Giddens (182) are tied for third.

In the 4th Flight, Megha Mani (185) has a solid lead over second place Jordan Sanders (193) and third place Makinley Kamp (195).

The 5th Flight is led by Emily Owens (217), Piper Lawrence (230) and Emma Culver (231).

Round 3 of the tournament begins tomorrow and will be played at Shady Oaks Country Club (Championship and 1st Flights), Shady Valley Country Club (2nd – 5th Flights) and Sycamore Creek Golf Course (9-Hole Division). Tee times and locations can be found at www.fwjga.net.

The Fort Worth Junior Golf Association conducts the annual Fort Worth City Boys and Girls City Junior Golf Championships. The tournaments traditionally are in July and are free for participants. There are no entry fees and no greens fees, and courses played include Fort Worth municipals and country clubs. There are eligibility rules, which a link can be found on the menu. The tournaments are open to boys and girls 8 to 18 years old. The boys tournament has been conducted since 1936 and the girls tournament since 1974. Thanks to the generousities of the City of Fort Worth and the country clubs, which donate their courses each year, there never has been a fee for participants.
